Emerging Together as a Eucharistic Church Committed to Justice

As the November meeting of the USCCB approaches, come reflect on the themes of the draft pastoral letter on the Eucharist. First, Eucharist as a mystery to be believed invites critical examination of the Pew study so as not to misunderstand what Catholics believe. Second, Eucharist as a mystery to be celebrated invites reflection on justice in the liturgy. Third, Eucharist as a mystery to be lived invites reflection on the church's mission promoting justice in the world. Our speaker is Angela Senander, a theologian with experience directing the Institute for Catholicism and Citizenship as an associate professor at the University of St. Thomas and serving as Chair of the Department of Systematic and Moral Theology at Washington Theological Union. She is the author of *Scandal: The Catholic Church and Public Life* (Liturgical Press).
